

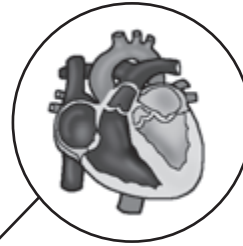
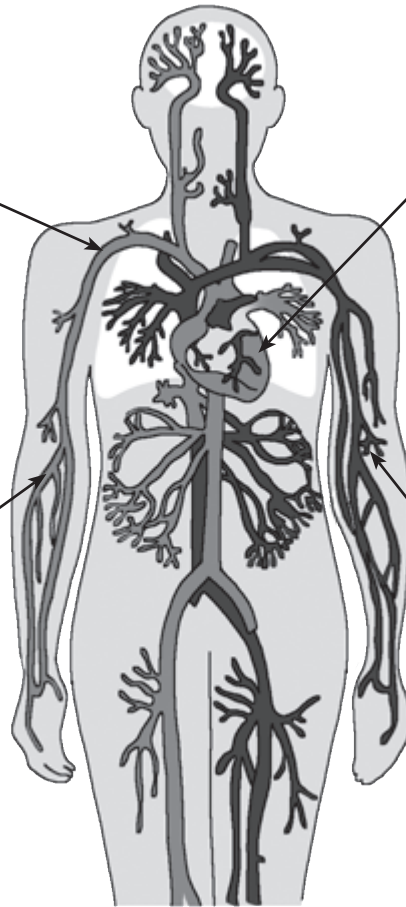
**1**  Label the circulatory system.

This carries blood back to the heart from the rest of our body.

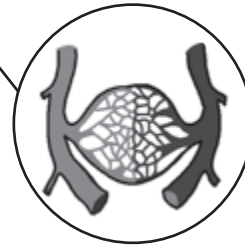
**b** \_\_\_\_\_
