## Speaking

## Teaching notes

For each item, award one point for accuracy and one point for ability to communicate well.

Ask students to look at the picture for a minute or so. Then invite them to describe the picture. Elicit a few examples, e.g. I can see / There's a kitchen. There are two sofas in the living room. There are two bathrooms. He's in the kitchen. She's in the bathroom. Then ask students questions individually about the picture. Here are some example questions:

Is he/she in the kitchen/bathroom/bedroom/ living room?

Is the (bed/cooker/fridge/sofa) in the (kitchen/ bathroom/bedroom/living room/hall)?

What is he/she wearing? (A dress/skirt/trousers/ jumper/T-shirt/an apron).

Has he/she got (glasses/a beard/a moustache/ a guitar)?

Has he/she got (short/long/straight/curly/fair/dark) hair?

You can also ask students to imagine they are the boy or the girl in the picture. Ask Do you want to play a board game? Elicit the answer Yes, please. Then put the students in pairs to do a short role-play with other activities, e.g. play volleyball/basketball/table tennis, do yoga, etc. You can write these prompts on the board.

Example answers: I can see ... a mum/dad/brother/ sister/two bedrooms/two bathrooms/one living room/one kitchen/a necklace/mountains/a beach/a fridge/two sofas/a guitar/a board game/a comic/a model/a table tennis bat/trainers. He's/She's wearing an apron/a jumper/a T-shirt. He's got glasses/a moustache. She's got long fair hair. She's got straight dark hair. He's got curly hair. The T-shirt is dirty. They're playing a board game.
